

Handout on cost reduction for fees associated with child day care in the town of Radolfzell am Bodensee.

With the decision by the municipal council on 13/04/2021, an increase in fees for child day care facilities in Radolfzell was determined. The innovation of the Zeller Card, decided at the same time, has improved financial support for families.

Please note the following information:

From 01/09/2021, you will be entitled **to a 50% reduction in fees via the Zeller Card** provided you are eligible in accordance with the following criteria:

- a) **Single parents** with at least **one child** under the age of 18 entitled to receive child benefits living in a household provided they have a gross annual income of a **maximum of €50,000**
- b) **Families** with at least **one child** under the age of 18 entitled to receive child benefits living in a household provided they have a gross annual income of a **maximum of €60,000**
- c) **Families** with at least **two children** under the age of 18 entitled to receive child benefits living in a household provided they have a gross annual income of a **maximum of €70,000**

The Zeller Card can be requested from the Town of Radolfzell, Citizen's Office and at buerginformation@radolfzell.de by submitting your most recent tax notice.

When the Zeller Card is submitted to the child day-care facility, the town will charge the reduced amount. **Please note that any submission for the coming month must always be made by the 10th of the previous month. Submissions cannot be corrected retroactively.**

Expiry and renewal of proof of eligibility

The reduction in child day-care fees will apply until the validity of the respective Zeller Card expires. This will remain valid for one year from the date of issue and can be extended for a further year provided the conditions for its issue are still met. Following an extension, please re-submit your Zeller Card to the child day-care facility for registration. Only then can fees be reduced once again.
